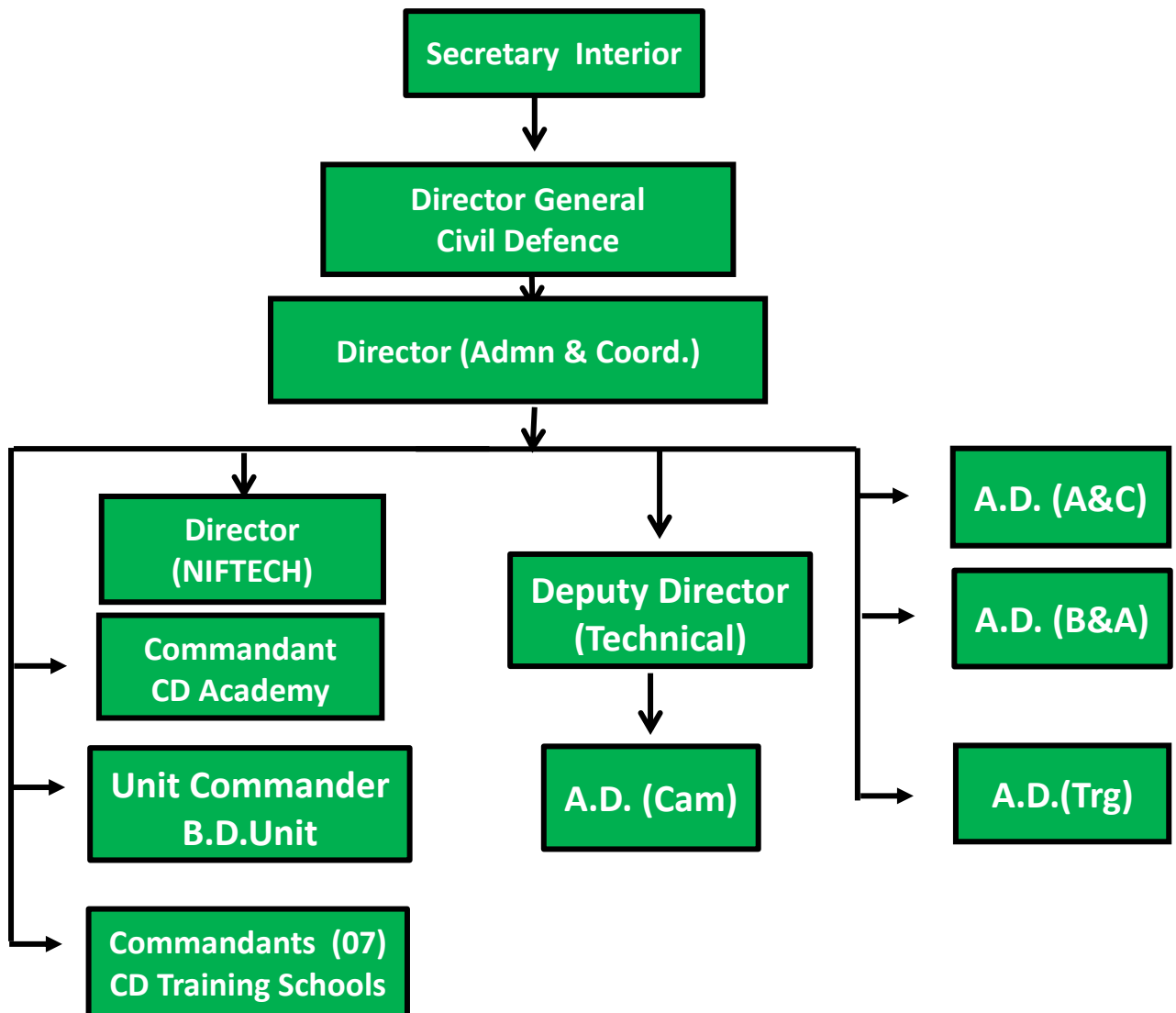
## Aims
