

Pursuant to the directives of Director General Civil Defence, Ch. Muhammad Ali Randhawa, the Directorate General Civil Defence, in collaboration with the Capital Development Authority (CDA), has developed a comprehensive civil defence training program for schools and colleges in Islamabad. The program aims to equip students with essential skills to respond effectively to emergencies, enabling them to play a vital role in saving lives and property. The training and awareness initiative is progressing rapidly. To implement this, ten (10) teams comprising 20 master trainers from Civil Defence and CDA have been deployed in the field since May 13. In the first phase, 70 schools were selected, and the Civil Defence training program was formally launched on May 13, 2025. Thousands of students from 50 schools have already received training, including practical demonstrations.
